When ICD-10 was being introduced several years ago, I assumed that the long-ignored condition of posterior tibial tendon dysfunction (PTTD) would finally have its own diagnosis code. Although disappointing, but not surprising, the coding experts who gave input into the new ICD-10 terminology did not think that PTTD was worthy of an individual code despite its frequency in the general population.

The posterior tibial tendon lies in the deep posterior compartment of the leg and is the most medial tendinous structure that crosses the ankle joint in relation to the medial malleolus. The medial malleolus itself acts as a pulley through which the tendon exerts its force as it acutely changes direction in comparison to the other long flexors of the deep posterior muscle compartment of the leg.
